City of Texarkana, Texas Regulations for CEVMS  
(Changeable Electronic Variable Message Signs)

Are you a school, church,  
hospital, college,  
university or civic center?

No. Are you  
located on one of  
the following  
streets?

- Moores Lane
- Richmond north of Moores Ln.
- Pleasant Grove Rd.
- Texas Blvd.
- Galleria Oaks
- Cowhorn Creek Rd. north of I-30

Yes. Do you exist  
in one of the  
following zones?

- Agriculture,
- SF-1, SF-2 or SF-3
- PUR
- 2F-1 or 2F-2
- TH
- MF-1 or MF-2
- Office or
- Neighborhood Services

Yes.

- CEVMS are not allowed in these zones except for institutional uses.

No. Do you  
exist in one of the  
following zones?

- General Retail
- Limited Commercial
- Central Business
- Commercial
- Industrial-1,
- Industrial 2
- Planned Dev.

Yes.

- CEVMS will be allowed no larger than 24 sq. ft. in size measured by the square footage of the sign face.
- CEVMS in these zoning districts will be turned off from 10:00 p.m. - 7:00 a.m.
- Maximum overall sign size structure can be no larger than 70 sq. ft. in size and 8 ft. in height.
- If at any time the institutional use changes, the signage must conform to applicable zoning district regulations.

Yes.

CEVMS will be allowed no larger than 32 sq. ft. in size measured by the square footage of the sign face.

No.

CEVMS will not be allowed in the following districts Agriculture, SF-1, SF-2, SF-3, PUR, 2F-1, 2F-2, TH, MF-1, MF-2, Office and Neighborhood Services.
